

ECO-FRIENDLY TIPS FOR PTO-SPONSORED EVENTS





- Use electronic invitations.
- Reuse decorations from past events or borrow from clubs that have recently held events.
- Ask families to donate gently used decorations.

02 Reusable or Compostable

- Avoid all disposable products.
- Tell folks ahead of time that you will be serving drinks in large pitchers, so they should bring reusable water bottles.
- Borrow a cooler from a sports team!
- Ask families to donate leftover supplies, or purchase compostable plates & utensils.

- Partner with local businesses that use sustainable practices, such as <u>Judith's Kitchen</u>, <u>Grape Leaf</u>, <u>Little Lukes</u>, and Clover Food <u>Lab</u>.
- Avoid individually wrapped items.
- Go big on vegetarian options.

Leftovers

- Request in advance that folks bring reusable containers for leftovers.
- Items also can be donated to the Newton <u>Freedge</u>.
- <u>Compost!</u> If your school does not have composting service, you
 can drop it off for free at Rumford Ave's Resource Recovery Center.
